Recital Fee

A recital performance fee of **\$35 per dancer will be processed on May 2**. This fee goes toward the costs associated with producing our fantastic shows such as theater rental, lighting & sound, venue staff, security, etc.

In addition, **your recital fee includes:**

- Digital Video Downloads of all recital performances! **(New this year!!!)**
- A full-color recital program for each dancer
- A special gift for each dancer at the end of their shows

Recital Tickets

Families of performing dancers will have **priority access to our ticket site April 25 to May 8**. To ensure that every family has tickets to watch their performer, a maximum of six (6) tickets per family, per show will be available to purchase during the priority access period. If there are tickets remaining after priority access ends, the site will open to the public on May 9 and more tickets can be purchased at that time. Tickets are \$18 for adults and \$14 for children 12 and under.

An email will be sent on or before **April 25** with details for your priority access to the ticketing site. all families assigned to multiple shows will receive a discount code toward their ticket purchase.

Ticket sales close at 11:59 pm on May 21.

Bun Kits

Hair & Makeup

On recital day, female dancers will wear their hair in a bun on the crown of their head. For makeup, we recommend plum or gray eye shadow, pink cheeks, black mascara and a red lip.

Attendance

Weekly attendance in class is important as this is how your dancer will get ready for the big show! We will help our dancers prepare the best they can during their weekly class times. **There will be no on-stage dress rehearsal for the recital.**

Recital Day

Dancer Check in: Dancers will be given a check-in time. Please be sure your dancer arrives on time with hair & makeup done and in their first costume.

Label Everything! Please label shoes, tights, and costumes with your dancer's name. If you have more than one performance in a show, be sure all costumes are labeled and in a garment bag.

COVID procedures: At this time, the venue requires masks to be worn in the building. Only during the performance may dancers remove their masks. We will update you on any changes as we get closer to the recital date.
